Obama approval continues to fall

Raleigh, N.C. – Public Policy Polling's monthly national survey finds Barack Obama's approval rating dropping to 50%, continuing a gradual decline in his numbers over the last two months.

In May Obama was at 55%. That dropped to 52% in June before today's poll. Obama's decline comes largely as a result of a reduction in his bipartisan support. His approval among Republicans is now 12% after being in the 18-19% range in the previous two polls.

While he has maintained strong support from African Americans and Hispanics his approval has dipped to below 40% with whites. He's also seen a pretty large shift with moderates, from 67% approval to 61%.

Tested in hypothetical contests against some possible 2012 GOP opponents Obama still maintains leads similar to what he won in the popular vote against John McCain last fall. He has a nine point lead against Mitt Romney, eight point ones against Newt Gingrich and Sarah Palin, and a six point one against Mike Huckabee.

"Barack Obama's approval rating has dropped below what he earned at the polls last fall," said Dean Debnam, President of Public Policy Polling. "But voters don't seem to think any of the most well known Republicans are all that compelling either. The GOP's best hope for 2012 might be to put forward a new face, just as the Democrats did with Obama."


Huckabee has polled closest to Obama all four times PPP has done this survey.

PPP conducted a national survey of 577 voters from July 15th to 16th. The survey's margin of error is +/-4.1%. Other factors, such as refusal to be interviewed and weighting, may introduce additional error that is more difficult to quantify.
